In 2006, he was appointed to IREM’s National Federal Housing Advisory Board which meets with HUD, Rural Housing Services and the Treasury. He has earned the Housing Credit Certified Professional (HCCP) certification in 2003 which is awarded for educational achievement in the low income housing tax credit program. Burson has also earned the Specialist in Housing Credit Management (SHCM) Certification in 2005 awarded by NAHMA. He also received the Industry Stateman Award from the National Affordable Housing Management Association (NAHMA) for his years of outstanding leadership and service.
